



AVIA Board of Directors Updates

The following are updates from the AVIA Board of Directors subsequent to the Membership meeting held on September 5, 2009.

1. Jeff Huston was unanimously elected by the Board to be the Boat Dock Chairperson.
2. Paul Howard was unanimously elected by the Board to be the Beach Chairperson.
3. The Boat Dock Chairperson asked for and received a bid on using aluminum docks/fingers for replacements. The estimate was more than twice the amount of estimates for wood docks/fingers. The Board has decided to remain with the current plan of replacing the boat docks/fingers with wood.
4. Mike McLeod was appointed the chairperson of the Boat Dock Expansion and Implementation Committee. The first project of this committee is to apply to the Town of Bridgton to allow AVIA to increase the boat slips from 34 to 50. The committee will also prepare a Master Proposal for the expansion.
5. Application was made to the Town of Bridgton to increase the boat slips from 34 to 50 and it was approved!
